JudoScotland is the body responsible for organising Judo in Scotland. JudoScotland is recognised by sportsScotland and, through the British Judo Association, the International Judo Federation and the British Olympic Association.

**Membership**

Membership of JudoScotland is required to participate in any promotion examination (grading), course or competition organised under the auspices of JudoScotland. New members are issued with a JudoScotland Record Book, which is used to record grade and other qualifications. Existing members should quote their membership number if known.

**Membership Fees**

Membership fees, which are non-returnable, include postage at current second class rate, are as follows:

Junior (Under 8) Membership	£12.00
Junior Membership	£19.00
Senior Membership	£29.00

Please send a cheque or postal order made payable to JudoScotland or complete the relevant credit card details. PLEASE DO NOT SEND CASH. Membership applications are normally processed within 5 working days but may take longer during busy periods.

**Categories of Membership**

There are three categories of membership:

- 1 Junior (Under 8) membership is available to members aged five, six or seven and is renewable annually. Where the member is aged seven when taking out this membership they may take part in competitive judo after their eighth birthday.
- 2 Junior Membership is available to players aged between eight and fifteen years old (inclusive) and is renewable annually.
- 3 Senior Membership is issued to members aged sixteen years and over, and is renewable annually.
